

Dear Parents/Carers,

Sports Day – Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June

Weather permitting we will be holding Sports Day for Key Stage One (Y1, Y2) and Year 3 on the morning of Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June. The events will begin at 9.15 am. The children will have a short break 10.15-10.30 for refreshments and then the competitive events will resume until 11.30am. Finally there will be presentations of medals and trophies on the playground with miles of smiles and celebrations!

For Key Stage Two (Y4, Y5, Y6) the sports events will be on the afternoon of Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June. The events will begin at 12.30pm. The children will have a short break 1.30-1.40 for refreshments and then the competitive events will resume until 2.45pm. Finally there will be presentations of medals and trophies on the playground celebrating our sporting superstars!

If it is a very hot and sunny day the children will need a **hat, water bottle and sun cream** (applied by parents/carers before they come to school). As you can appreciate it takes great effort to organise an event of this nature and therefore we will endeavour for the event to go ahead and it will only be cancelled if there are very wet conditions. We have allocated one further date for our Sports day (26/06/19) if we are very unlucky with the weather.

We strongly advise parent/carers to walk to our Sports Day event to reduce the problem of traffic congestion around the school. If you do come by car we recommend that you use the car park behind the Elm Tree shops which is accessed via Foxwood Drive or Sainsbury's Car Park on Bishopton Avenue. Please avoid parking in Dunelm Road, Chingford Grove, Barlborough Avenue and Alford Lane.

We understand that Parent/Carers may be coming for both the morning and the afternoon events if they have children in different Key Stages and there will be an allocated waiting area on the field during the lunch hour. If you intend to wait you may wish to bring your own picnic chairs for your own comfort.

The Friends of the School will have refreshments on sale during the day so you may want to treat yourself to a Strawberry Tea!

It is a very exciting day for both children and Parents/Carers but the children will need to remain with their own class and teacher at all times. Please do not give your child any extra food/drinks during the events or ask to take them home early. The staff need to ensure that the children are supervised and will be handed over to parents/carers in the usual way at the end of the day.

In previous years we have had issues with photos being taken throughout the day. As you can understand due to safeguarding some children are unable to have their photos taken. We will, however, have photographs taken by staff members, which will be posted onto our School website for your own viewing.

Thank you for your co-operation and support and we look forward to a successful Sports Day.
