

Information sheet for Families– September 2020

It is everyone's responsibility to ensure we are all safe

Coming to and from school:

- Parent/Carer must check **daily** that their child is not displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 if so **they must stay at home**
- Parents/Carers are encouraged to travel to school in a sustainable manner and with consideration for the school neighbours
- Parent/Carer of children in **KS2** will bring their children to the **school gates only** and the children will be directed into school by a member of staff – doors will be open from 8.30am. The children will be brought to the gates at the end of the day at 3.00pm by the staff. Parent/carers of children in Y5 and Y6 can arrange to meet their child at a close specified meeting point outside the school gates.
- Only **one parent/carer per child of KS1 and EYFS** children will be allowed to come onto the school site (younger siblings are allowed in pushchairs etc.)
- Reception and KS1 doors will open at 8.45 am. Nursery Doors will open at 8.30am. EYFS and KS1 children can be collected from their class doors at 3.15pm only. Parents/Carers **will not be allowed onto the playground any sooner**. This is to allow the time for the KS2 children to leave the site.
- On the school map, it indicates where you will drop off and pick up your child. It also shows the room your child will be in except for outdoor play.
- Parents must observe the 1-2 metres social distancing whilst on the premises and **follow the yellow footprints for the one-way system**.
- **Please do not stay any longer than necessary at school gates or on the playground as this would increase congestion and therefore increase the risk of transmission**

The School Day:

- Each child will be assigned to their class of 30 pupils or less
- Each child will have their own set of resources
- The children will remain in their class all day and they will be supervised by two adults (this is to allow break times for staff)
- The classes will not be mixing across school until the Covid-19 restrictions are eased for schools
- Each class is on a rota for outdoor play and will have a playground or an area of the playground assigned to them and a box of equipment to be used only by them
- The children will resume their learning from the appropriate year group curriculum
- If your child were to develop any Covid-19 symptoms during the day they would be supervised by a member of staff in the medical room until the parent comes to collect

Keeping everyone safe:

- Staff and children will have a rigorous regime of hand washing throughout the day
- If your child or anyone in the household has any symptoms of Covid-19 then the child should not come into school. This is the same with school staff.
- Covid-19 testing is available for anyone over 5 years of age. Contact NHS 111 for further advice
- Parents/Carers must telephone school to make school aware if a child is not coming into school, the reason why and if Covid-19 is suspected
- If pupils have a Covid-19 test, parents must inform the school about the outcome of the test

Parents are not to enter the school site unless dropping off or picking up KS1 or EYFS Children. This is to protect the staff and children on the school site.
