


1 Teaching

- **Focus on the critical aspects we need to teach well.** A package of home remote learning put together ensuring we focus on **basic skills first and foremost.** (Lexia, readtheory.com, Phonics Play, writing linked to the topic, TT Rockstars and MyMaths)
- **TEAMS or ZOOM used as a platform** for delivering lessons and feedback is provided by teachers via email. Initial preparation included training staff and coaching children in its use.
- **Face-to-face teaching** focusing on key ideas and setting up the home learning with modelling, explanations and immediate feedback—sharing the metacognitive steps needed to complete a task.
- **Home learning** focuses on targeted tasks, independent practice (with prompts and keywords provided) and short quizzes – all opportunities to embed concepts in the long-term memory with reinforcement activities provided via workbooks during summer holidays.
- **Feedback** on tasks given via face-to-face learning or through home learning email.



2 Targeted academic support

- **Positive discrimination:** expectation that all vulnerable learners in school full-time, experiencing quality first teaching and support with follow-up.
- **Vulnerable learners** not in school receive graded support as indicated by monitoring system e.g. accessibility to a device, paper copies, extra phone calls to support learning and well-being, bespoke feedback.
- **Bespoke and targeted learning packs** for specific children, including those with EHCPs.

3 Wider strategies

- Based on **strong relationships:** communication with families (and staff) made easier by the strength of relationships already in place meaning that families trust the school's approaches and support the strategies in place for learning as well as well-being.
- **Weekly/biweekly phone-calls/distanced visits** support wellbeing of vulnerable pupils
- **Delivery of work packs** and support from PSA
- **Use of the PSA** and the admin team to act as a link between school and home, supporting families to establish routines to support home learning
